

Pastor Bill's Devotional "In Christ"

The phrases "In Christ," "in Him," "in the beloved", "in Me", etc.. occur 164 times in the New Testament. This phrase means being joined to Him, in union with Him. Or what is true of Him is true of us. Like a branch in the vine. Paul often mentioned his ways in Christ.

"For this reason I have sent Timothy to you, who is my beloved and faithful son in the Lord, who will remind you of my ways in Christ, as I teach everywhere in every church."

I Corinthians 4:17 NKJV

All believers are placed in Christ the moment they are born again. At that moment, they became a new creature, where your old man has died and your new man has come alive.

"Therefore, if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things have become new." II Corinthians 5:17 KJV

Try to see yourself as God sees you "in Christ". Who you are "In Christ" is your truest or real identity.

Your behavior doesn't determine your identity, instead, your identity determines your behavior.


